To: Community Members of Cabarrus and Stanly County

Do you know someone special who works with young children in our area?

The Hearts and Hands Award has been established to recognize the contributions of early childcare professionals who support a high-quality preschool experience. These professionals play a critical role in a child's educational, physical, social and emotional development by nurturing a child's confidence, inspiring their imagination and creativity, and by advocating for the well-being of children and their families.

The CTFC Committee would like to recognize outstanding professionals, one in each category below, who make a difference in the lives of young children of Cabarrus or Stanly County.

Eligibility

Nominations are open to all preschool professionals of Cabarrus or Stanly County. Nominees must meet the following criteria:

- Be a current or former employee of a Cabarrus and/or Stanly County full or part-day early childcare facility or church-based program, a homecare provider or public, charter or private school or agency serving children 0-8.
- Has worked in, or in support of, early childcare a minimum of three years.
- Be nominated by a person affiliated with the preschool program (e.g. colleague, administrator, supervisor, parent of a student, preschool board member etc.)
- Cannot be a past recipient of the Hearts and Hands Award
- Be in good standing with no active contractual infractions and/or recent state licensing violations.

Selection Process

Nominations will be screened and scored by a panel of non-partial educators and early childhood education experts, looking at the following...

Criteria:

- A commitment to excellence in teaching or service; a willingness to go "above and beyond."
- -Enthusiasm for the care and education of young children.
- -Positive relationships with colleagues, the preschool and the community.
- Nominations must be received by February 10, 2023
- Awards will be presented at the Annual Coming Together for Children Conference to be held this year on Saturday, February 25, 2023 at Crossroads Church 220 George W Liles Pkwy NW Concord NC The Awards Ceremony will begin at 12:15 in the church sanctuary.
