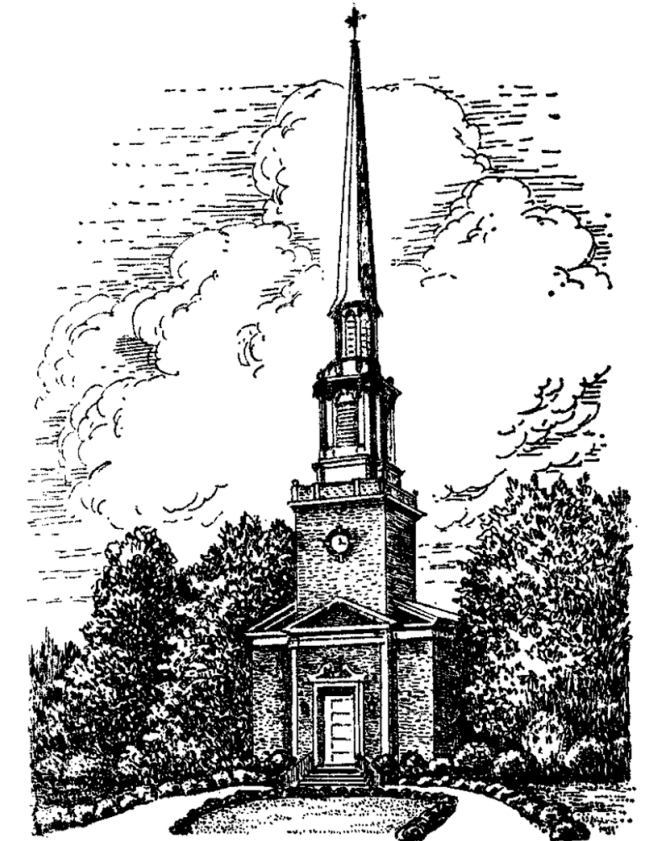
ANNOUNCEMENTS
